

Museum Manners

To ensure an unforgettable experience, we want your staff and students to feel prepared. The following guidelines and information should be reviewed prior to your visit.

- 1. Sanitize upon entry and during transitions.
- 2. Please wear a mask if unvaccinated, over your nose and under your chin as indicated by Maine CDC. Maintaining 3 6 ft distancing whist in the galleries and ArtLab.
- 3. Please use walking feet and stay with your group.
- 4. Be aware of your surroundings, as the CMCA we provide unique installations. Artwork may be installed on floors, walls, ceilings, and more.
- 5. No food or drink is permitted in the galleries.
- 6. Pencils are the only writing tool permitted in the galleries and can be provided by museum educators.
- 7. No-flash photography permitted throughout the galleries, please silent any cellphones and stow away any form of selfie stick before entering.
- 8. Large bags and umbrellas must be checked at the front desk. We will provide coat racks for lunch box and jacket storage.
